PARIS

Bursting with culture, elegance and cosmopolitan "joie de vivre", language students will be inspired by the French capital to bring their classroom learning to life.

POPULAR ITINERARY

Day 1: Travel by Eurostar right into the heart of Paris, drop your bags and head out on a Guided Walking Tour of the city in French or English. Take a cruise along the River Seine listening to the on-board French commentary.

Day 2: Take your pick from one of Paris' excellent museums or galleries; the Louvre, Musee D'Orsay or Cite des Sciences. Climb the Montparnasse Tower and complete their KS 3 & 4 language worksheets whilst getting some fabulous views over the city.

Day 3: Soak up the atmosphere of a Parisian market, where you can test out your language skills and converse with the locals. Enjoy a backstage tour, in French of one of Paris' popular theatres and finish with a performance with English subtitles to aid understanding.

Day 4: Visit the Arc de Triomphe with free time and shopping on the Champs Elysees before you board the Eurostar and return home.

COLOGNE
